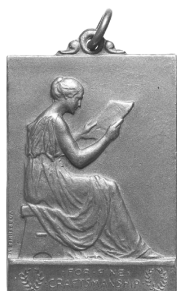


Presentation of Student Medals



THE HANEY MEDAL

This medal is awarded to a ninth or tenth grade student in each high school who has demonstrated the most growth and potential in the field of art. This medal was originally designed in 1909 by Victor D. Brenner and exhibited at The American Numismatic Society in 1910. It was named for James Parton Haney, the first Vice President of The School Art League.
